Business Transformation II builds on first study, exploring factors that drive business sustainability:

What **skillsets** and **core competencies** do we need in changing operating environment?

Do we need to adjust our organization's **tolerance for risk**?

What **governance** and **internal organizational capacities** do we need to remain sustainable?

Business Transformation II: Why?

Study goals:

- Support housing organizations to successfully transform their business by sharing findings,
- Inform government and the non-profit sector about the changing needs of housing providers

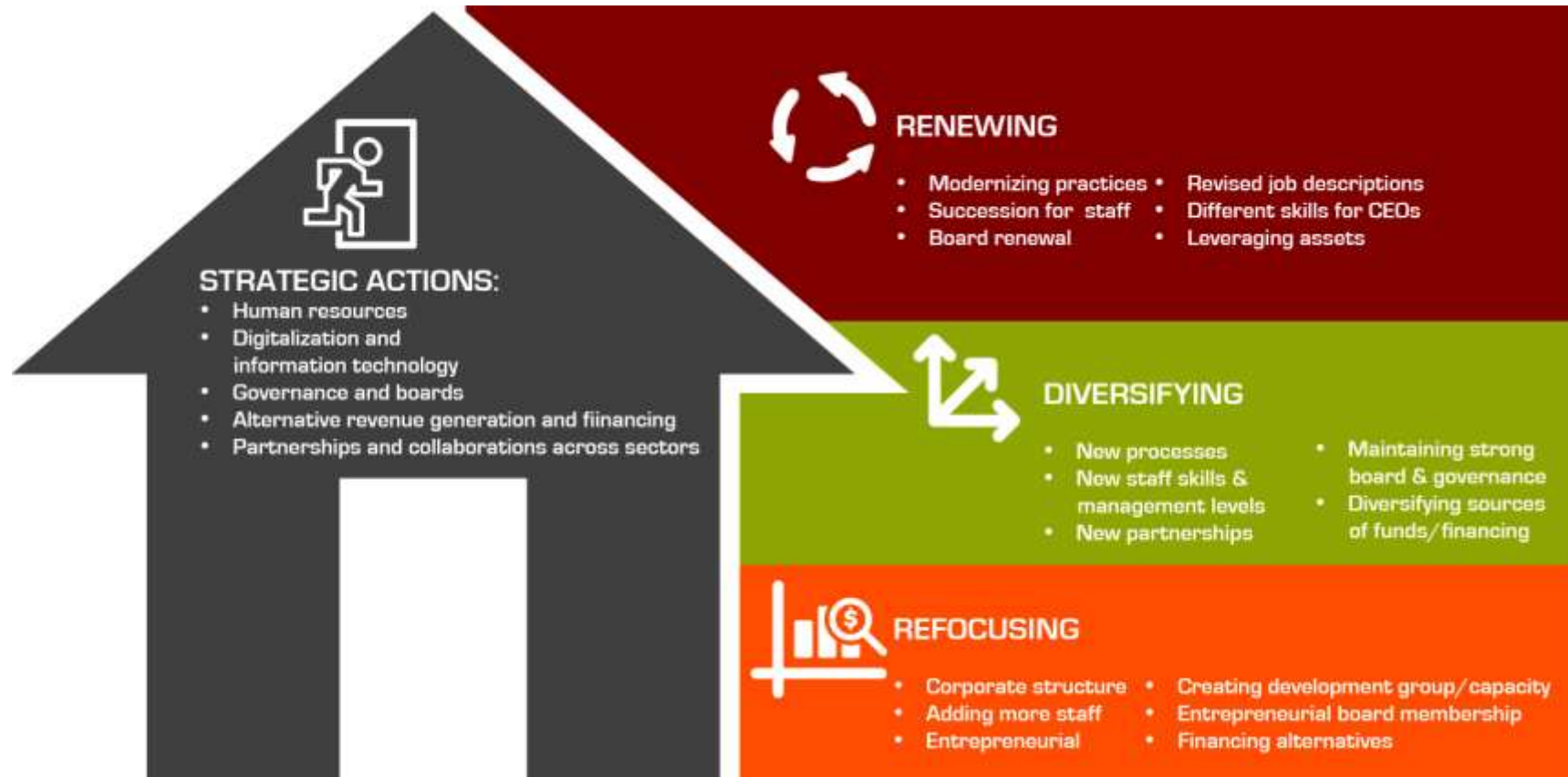
Findings based on

- 213 completed online surveys

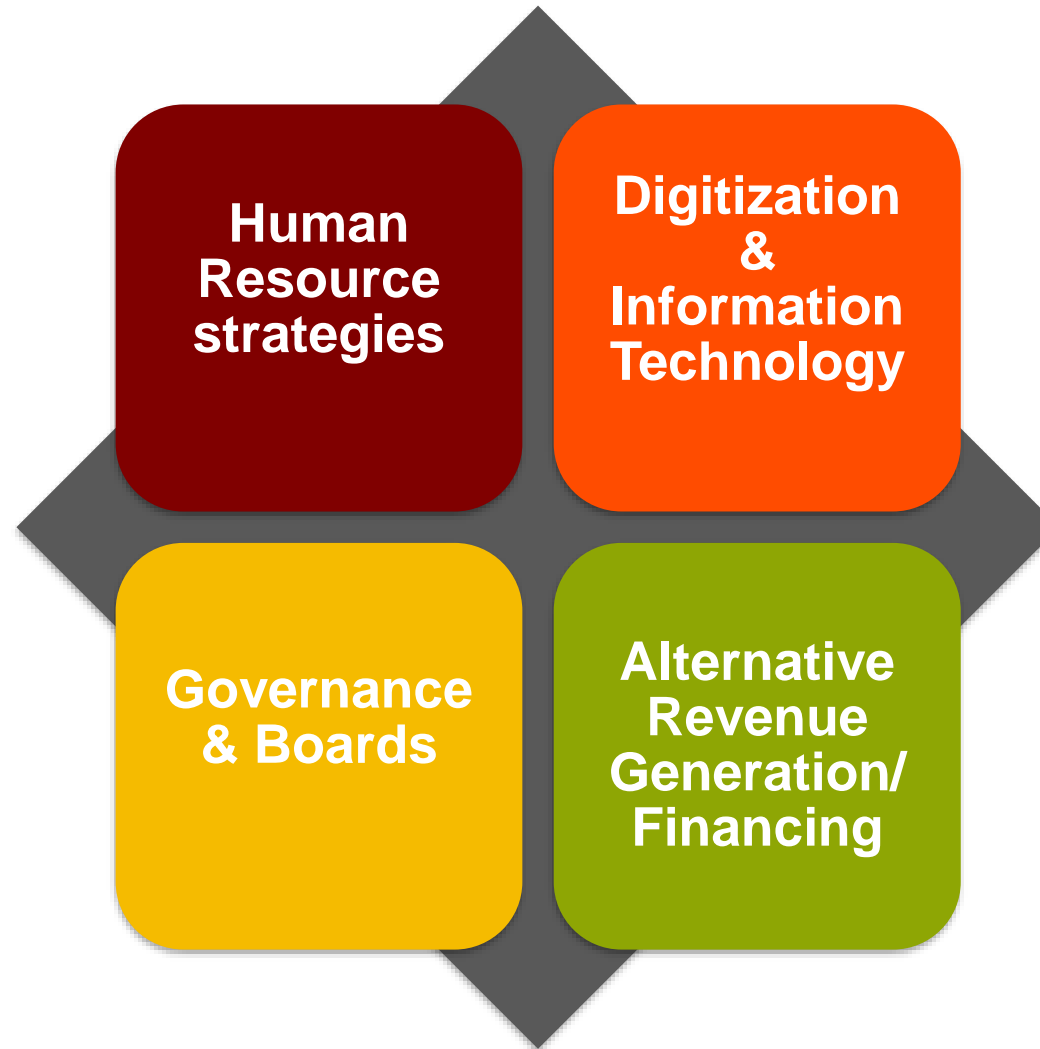
First study of its kind in Canada in terms of scale and diversity of participants
