

## **Highlights**

- The vacancy rate for standard spaces in Quebec stood at 7.2% in 2019, compared to 6.9% last year.
- Vacancy rate trends and market conditions differed across the regions.
- The average monthly rent for standard spaces was \$1,788.
- The capture rate in Quebec was 18.4% in 2019, contrasting sharply with the overall rate of just 6.1% for the other Canadian provinces.
- The vacancy rate for heavy care spaces in Quebec rose to 5.7% in 2019.




# Vacancy rate in Quebec shows a small increase in 2019

According to the latest Seniors' Housing Survey conducted in Quebec by Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC), the vacancy rate for standard spaces (spaces where the residents receive less than I.5 hours of care per day or are not required to pay an extra amount to receive high-level care) registered a small increase this year.

In fact, between 2018 and 2019, the vacancy rate in the province of Quebec rose from 6.9% to 7.2%. Over the past two years, this rate therefore went up by I percentage point. This contrasts with the situation observed from 2013 to 2017, over which time the vacancy rate had decreased by 2.5 percentage points. As mentioned in the 2018 report, the rebound in construction in this market segment, which started in 2015, likely caused supply to outpace demand, driving up the vacancy rate.2 This renewed activity was attributable mainly to the fact that developers, anticipating a more sustained increase in demand over the coming years as a result of the aging of the population, have already begun positioning themselves on the market by starting new projects.

These demographic changes have also been having impacts on supply in the other segments of the rental market in the province. Indeed, in some centres, the increase in certain alternative housing types, including conventional rental apartments and rental condominiums, has been providing competition for seniors' housing spaces. While these alternative types of housing do not offer the same range of services than seniors' residences, they have been

able to meet part of the demand for seniors' housing spaces, particularly from independent older clients.

Data on vacancy rates for seniors' housing spaces by unit type in Quebec have in fact continued to show a lower vacancy rate for apartments (6.4%) than for rooms (9.9%). With vacancy rates between 5% and 6%, larger apartments (one-bedroom and two-bedroom) posted a better rental performance than smaller units, namely, bachelor units (vacancy rate of 8.9%).

## Market trends differ across the regions

Private seniors' housing market conditions are obviously not the same everywhere across the province. The small change in the provincial vacancy rate between 2018 and 2019 effectively conceals contrasting trends across the regions.

In the Montréal and Québec census metropolitan areas (CMAs), the two largest markets in the province, the vacancy rates for standard spaces moved in opposite directions. The rates rose in Montréal and fell slightly in Québec. Market conditions became similar in these two CMAs, with the proportions of unoccupied spaces reaching 7.1% and 7.2%, respectively, in 2019 (versus 6.5% and 7.6% in 2018). It should be noted, however, that there were marked differences in the proportions of unoccupied spaces depending on the geographic sectors within these areas.

Elsewhere in the province, the vacancy rates for standard spaces increased in the Gatineau area (from 5.4% to 7.3%) but decreased in the Sherbrooke CMA (from 10.9% to 8.4%), the Trois-Rivières CMA (from 9.7% to 7.1%) and the Saguenay CMA (from 6.3% to 4.3%). While notable, these changes do not necessarily reflect long-term trends in these markets. For example, the increase in the Gatineau area this year followed a decrease of similar magnitude last year, such that market conditions there have not really changed in recent years.

## **Average rents**

The average monthly rent for standard spaces in seniors' residences in Quebec reached \$1,788 in 2019. Of course, the averages varied significantly with the unit types: from \$1,487 for bachelor units to \$2,307 for two-bedroom apartments. Differences were also noted depending on the areas, with average rents hovering between \$1,599 in Saguenay and \$2,140 in Gatineau.

The services offered in seniors' residences in Quebec (sports facilities, housekeeping help, recreational services, etc.) vary greatly from one establishment to another. A wide variety of services can be included, or not, in the rents paid by residents. Average rent data must therefore be analyzed with caution.

# Capture rate: Quebec stands out from the rest of Canada

The "capture rate," as defined in this report, is the proportion of the population aged 75 or older living in private seniors' residences.<sup>3</sup>

In Quebec, the capture rate was estimated at 18.4% in 2019—the highest proportion in Canada. The closest Canadian province was Prince Edward Island, with a capture rate of 10.5%. In the other Atlantic

provinces, the Prairies, the Western provinces and Ontario, the capture rates varied between 1.9% and 8.7%. In fact, excluding Quebec, the average capture rate for the rest of Canada reached just 6.1% in 2019.

In other words, while about one in five people aged 75 or older lived in seniors' residences in Quebec, this was the case for only around one in twenty in the other provinces across the country. This contrast does not automatically mean that people aged 75 or older in the rest of Canada do not change tenure. It could be that a number of them go from owning to renting, without necessarily moving into "specialized" residences.

As well, the proportion of renter households aged 75 or older was significantly lower in the rest of Canada<sup>4</sup> (24%) than in Quebec (40%). A large percentage of older households in the other Canadian provinces therefore still owned their homes, which was much less the case in Quebec.

## Capture rates varied across Quebec CMAs

Among Quebec's CMAs, Trois-Rivières and Sherbrooke once again had the highest capture rates, both at about 25%. In fact, nearly one in four people aged 75 or older in these urban centres lived in seniors' residences.

They were followed by the Québec CMA, with a capture rate of 21%, and then by the Saguenay and Montréal CMAs, with rates just under 20%.<sup>5</sup>

## Heavy care spaces

The survey defines "heavy care spaces" as those where the residents pay an extra amount to receive 1.5 hours or more of care per day. According to the data from the latest survey in 2019, conditions in this market segment eased over the past year. The vacancy rate in this segment was estimated at 5.7% this year, compared to 4.2% in 2018.


Conditions were not the same across the large urban centres, though, as the vacancy rates increased in Montréal and Trois-Rivières but remained stable or decreased in the other CMAs across the province. The average monthly rent reached \$3,281 for Quebec overall, but the level could rise to about \$3,600 for units located in the Sherbrooke area.

Over the longer term, when the baby boomers will get to the point where they will begin to lose their independence, many challenges will emerge for the housing sector, particularly in the heavy care segment, given the significant needs for human and financial resources associated with that stage of life.

# **Methodology**

Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation conducts the Seniors' Housing Survey in February and March. This annual survey became national in scope in 2009, covering all centres in each of the ten provinces. Both private and non-profit residences are included in the survey universe.

To be eligible for inclusion in the survey results, a residence must:

- √ have at least one unit that is not subsidized (in the Atlantic provinces, Quebec and Ontario);
- √ have been in operation for at least one year (for example, it must have started operation before January 2015 to be included in the 2016 survey);
- √ have at least 10 rental units (in Quebec, Ontario and the Prairies) or 5 rental units (in the Atlantic provinces and B.C.);
- √ offer an on-site meal plan;
- √ not mandate high levels of health care (defined as 1.5 hours or more of care per day) to all of its
  residents; nursing homes and long-term care homes are examples of residences that were not included
  in the survey (Exception: British Colombia for select Optional Tables only);
- ✓ offer rental units; life lease units and owner-occupied units are excluded from this survey; and
- ✓ have at least 50 per cent of its residents who are 65 years of age or older.

The Seniors' Housing Survey is a census and not a sample survey; therefore, all seniors' residences in Canada meeting these criteria are to be part of this survey. The survey universe in Quebec may include private residences that do not meet the conditions for obtaining a certificate of compliance.

Survey data were obtained through a combination of telephone interviews and fax and e-mail responses. Information was obtained from the residence owner, manager or administrator. Survey results reflect market conditions at the time of the survey. Survey results have been weighted to adjust for non-responses, in order to ensure that they are reflective of the universe. The level of statistical reliability is noted in the data tables. For more information on the reliability of the data, please click <a href="here">here</a>.

# **Definitions**

**Space:** A space is a residential area that is rented out. Examples of spaces include one half of a semi-private unit, a private or bachelor unit, a one-bedroom unit and a two-bedroom unit. In most cases, a space is the same as a unit. The exception is the case where a unit has been divided to rent to multiple residents. Semi-private and ward units are an example of this. Unless otherwise indicated, data for spaces are for all unit types.

**Standard space:** A space where the resident does not receive high-level care (that is, the resident receives less than 1.5 hours of care per day) or is not required to pay an extra amount to receive high-level care. Regional terms for this type of space may vary across the country.

**Heavy care space:** A space where the resident is paying an extra amount to receive high-level care (1.5 hours or more of care per day). Examples of conditions that could require high-level care include Alzheimer's, dementia and reduced mobility.

**Respite space:** A space used to provide temporary accommodation for a senior who normally lives in another place and not at the residence.

**Non-market or subsidy space:** A space where the rent received for the space is less than market rent or where the resident occupying the space is subsidized.

**Rent:** The actual amount a resident pays per month for his or her accommodation space and all mandatory services. For vacant spaces, the rent is the amount the owner is asking for the space.

**Vacancy:** A space is considered vacant if, at the time of the survey, it is physically unoccupied and available for immediate rental.

**Capture rate:** The main age group living in seniors' residences are persons aged 75 years and older. Capture rate in a centre is the ratio of the total number of residents living in the survey universe divided by its estimated 75+ population, expressed as a percentage.
